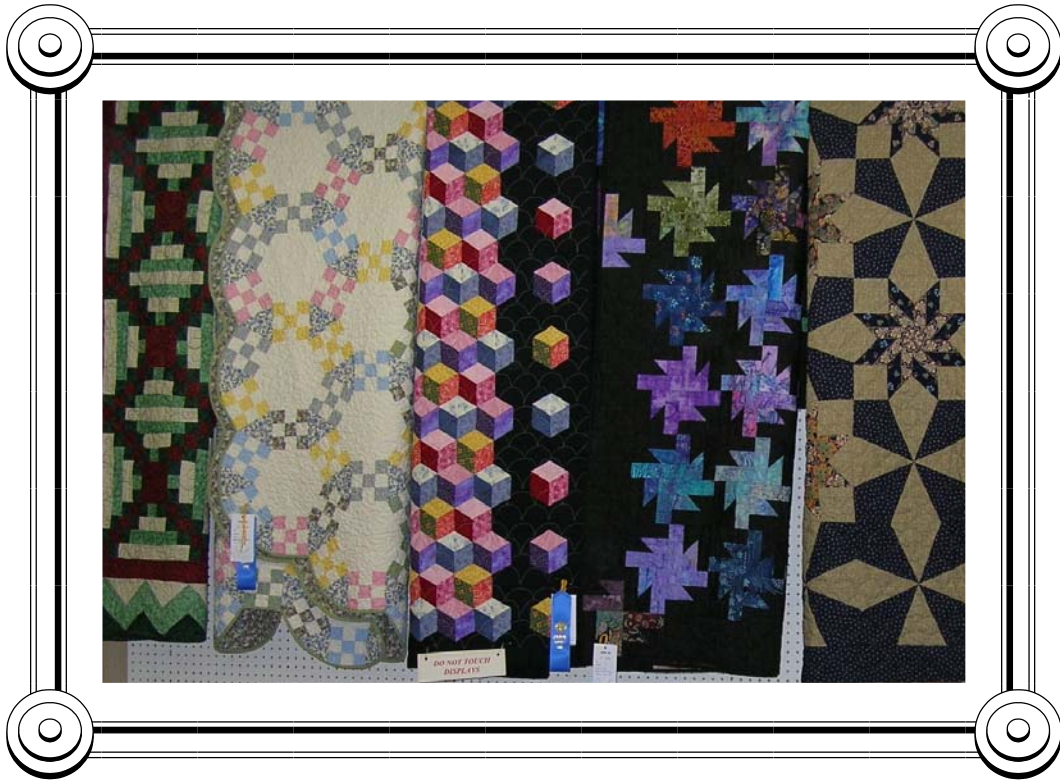

• • OPEN CLASS EXHIBITS • •

General Rules

These rules apply to all divisions.

1. Entries are open to anyone, any age level. If an article is made under a handicap, this disability should be stated for judging purposes.
2. All entries must have been grown or made by the exhibitor. Unfinished, soiled, or articles showing signs of wear, may not be entered. All entries are judged, based on quality, workmanship, and neatness. There is no entry fee.
3. Because of limited space we must reserve the right to refuse any article we consider too large to display properly or any article or entry of questionable content.
4. Send entry blanks to the fairgrounds. Exhibitors **MUST** send in entry blanks postmarked no later than July 15, 2006 - so we can plan for exhibit space except for Garden. **NO EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS AN ENTRY BLANK HAS BEEN SENT IN.** For entry blanks, see the website or list items and information on a plain sheet of paper. Additional entry blanks may be obtained at the Dubuque County Fair Office or any of the chairpersons listed. No telephone entries.
5. **NEW!** All exhibits must be entered at the Creative Arts Building on Saturday, July 22, 2006 from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. except Division E - Garden Show. Entries will be tagged when entered. Classification of entries may be changed at the discretion of the chairperson of each division.
6. Hours for the Creative Arts Building - July 25, 2006 to July 30, 2006, will be Tuesday through Saturday from 12:00 pm - 8:00 pm and Sunday from 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
7. The management will use the utmost care to guard exhibits. **WE CANNOT BE HELD LIABLE.**
8. Release time on exhibits that can be carried will be from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 30, 2006. **NO EARLY RELEASES. NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE EXHIBIT AREA SUNDAY NIGHT.** Monday, July 31, 2006 release time will be from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** The Management is not responsible for exhibits left on the fairgrounds after release hours.
9. Awards for "Best of Show" will be awarded in each division. No person may win "Best of Show" in the same division two years in a row.
10. **RIBBON POLICY:** Ribbon placement is as follows: Blue: 1st; Red: 2nd; Green: 3rd.

Kids Korner

Rules & Regulations

1. All General Creative Rules Apply to the Kid's Korner Rules.
2. All kids up to and including age 14 may exhibit in the "Kids Korner" division. Entries for Divisions E & F are not restricted by this rule.
3. An exhibitor may enter any class. Division E & F entries must be sent to the chairpersons of those divisions.
4. Six "Best of show" ribbons may be awarded.
5. The management will use the utmost care to guard and protect exhibits; however we can and will not be held liable.
6. All kids' ages must be included on the entry form.

RULES

1. **See General Rules - Open Class.**
2. Entries may be in color or black and white. Single photos or groups of 3 or 4 photos that are related may be entered. More than one entry may be made in each class.
3. Maximum allowable entries per individual: 5.
4. The exhibitor must have taken photographs, but it is not necessary that exhibitor do processing.
5. **Any size photograph will be acceptable but MUST be mounted on poster board OR matt board appropriate for the picture or pictures.** Minimum size for poster board or matt board is 8"x10". No framed pictures accepted.
6. Exhibitor's name and address, and class number of photo MUST be indicated on the back of the entry.
7. Ribbons will be awarded solely on the basis of individual merit. Judging will be done on general interest and visual appeal.
8. A "Best of Show" award will be given in the Beginner and Advanced Divisions.

2. All work must be original. No kits or molds may be used.
3. All work **MUST** be ready to hang on pegboard. Masking tape and string are not acceptable. Articles without either matting or frame will not be judged or displayed. Each article should have an identification card attached to the back. **ANY WORK NOT FOLLOWING THESE RULES WILL BE RETURNED TO THE EXHIBITOR.**
4. All entries will be judged and exhibited at the discretion of the committee. Ribbons will be awarded solely on the basis of artistic excellence.
5. Classification of entries may be changed at the discretion of the chairperson.
6. The management will use the utmost care in displaying and guarding the exhibits but assumes no liability.
7. Children under high school age must send entries to Kids Korner and use Classes 1 - 13.

RULES

1. **See General Rules - Open Class.**
2. No entries accepted from dealers or professionals.
3. All articles will be placed in closed glass case (unless too large) and locked, until exhibitors pick them up at the time specified in the general rules.
4. The management will use the utmost care to guard and protect exhibitors. NOT LIABLE.
5. Any article that has not received a blue ribbon at our fair in the past will be eligible for judging. This applies to Division F Antiques ONLY.
6. Send all entries to chairperson listed above.
7. No cracked or chipped antiques.
8. No tape on antiques.
