**BY 10:00 AM! NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

**\*PLEASE READ ALL RULES CAREFULLY, SOME HAVE**  
**CHANGED!**

**DRIVER ENTRY:** Entries are open to Men and Women. In the interest of safety and in fairness to all competitors, the following rules and regulations will be enforced.

1. PREVIOUS DEMOLITION DERBY CARS ARE ALLOWED!
2. Driver must be 18 years of age or have a notarized permit from parent or guardian. NO COMPETITOR UNDER 16 YEARS OLD. In the event of any doubt, you must have a document stating proof of your age.
3. Driver must furnish his/her own car. (More power to you if you can obtain a Sponsor.)
4. American cars or station wagons allowed. NO 4 WHEEL DRIVE CARS, NO JEEPS, TRUCKS, CARRALLS, CONVERTIBLES.
5. 1966 OR OLDER LINCOLNS, IMPERIALS, OR THUNDERBIRDS, WILL BE ACCEPTED AND WILL BE PLACED IN THE STATION WAGON CLASS.
6. Driver may enter each heat but must have a different car for each heat.
7. ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED UP TO ONE HOUR (10:00 A.M.) TO DERBY TIME.
8. Drivers must sign entry blank and insurance (pit pass) releases prior to derby time. ENTRY FEE IS \$10.00 PER CAR, PIT PASS IS \$10.00.

**PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS:**

1. Drivers may maneuver forward or backward.
2. No direct driver's door hits. THIS WILL BE STRONGLY ENFORCED!
3. If a driver does not hit another car within one minute, said driver shall be disqualified. DO NOT PLAY POSSUM! THIS WILL ALSO BE STRONGLY ENFORCED!
4. Driver must remain in car until his/her car is removed by tow truck.

5. ALL drivers must attend meeting in pit area prior to derby time.
6. DRIVERS MUST REMAIN IN THE SAME CAR FOR FEATURE AS THEY QUALIFIED IN HEAT.
7. NO ONE, 14 THROUGH 17 YEARS OLD CAN ENTER PITS WITH OUT A NOTARIZED MINOR'S RELEASE. UNDER 14 YEARS OLD NOT ALLOWED IN PITS.
8. ANY CAR LOSING GLASS ON THE TRACK WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
9. LONG SLEEVE SHIRT AND FULL LENGTH PANTS ARE MANDATORY.
10. NO radio transmitting or listening devises, etc.
11. Must remain belted and wear a helmet at all times until ok'd by officials or you may be disqualified.

### **HEATS:**

Number of heats will be determined by number of entries. All cars must qualify through heats to be eligible to run in feature event.

### **ENTRY FEE:**

Each car entered shall pay \$10.00 Entry Fee.

Each person entering the pits shall pay \$10.00 Pit Pass. (Insurance Fee)

### **PREPARATION OF CARS:**

1. Slogans, advertising, or printing may be placed any place on car EXCEPT FRONT DOORS AND ROOF. **TENT SHAPED SIGN ON ROOF WITH NAME AND NUMBER IS REQUIRED, but NO ADVERTISING ON SIGN. A 36" X 36" SIGN IS REQUIRED. MUST HAVE SIGN ON ROOF OR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE DERBY.** Print driver's name above number on both front doors in LARGE PRINT. Use your choice of number. **NO LETTERS—ONLY NUMBERS!!!!**
2. Radiators and fans may be removed, BUT NOT RELOCATED. Batteries may be replaced in a secure position. Batteries need to be placed in a steel or heavy wooden box with lid to match. No more than two automobile batteries will be allowed. Bumpers and fenders may be trimmed. Bumpers can be chained with a 3/8-inch by 8-inch long chain per bumper shock.
3. ALL GLASS, BODY MOULDING, AND STOCK GAS TANK MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE REACHING THE FAIRGROUNDS.
4. APPROVED BOAT GAS TANK MUST BE SECURED IN BACK SEAT AREA. NO TANKS LARGER THAN SIX GALLONS. Electric fuel pumps are allowed in large cars, but must be mounted securely. Fuel pumps with return line must be blocked. No ether or starting fluid allowed. **GAS TANK MUST BE PLACED IN A SOLID, HEAVY WOODEN OR STEEL BOX WITH A SOLID LID. LID MUST BE EASILY REMOVABLE, BUT SECURE.** A Steel box is preferred, if box is made of wood it

must be made from 2X6 or 2X12 lumber. No boxes allowed if made from material less than 3/4" thick (partical board) for side walls and lids.

5. Batteries and fuel tank boxes must have steel straps with bolts. NO bungee, cords, NO seat belts, NO screws or NO wire allowed. **BATTERIES MUST BE PLACED IN A SOLID HEAVY WOODEN OR STEEL BOX WITH A SOLID LID. LID MUST BE EASILY REMOVABLE, BUT SECURE. BOXES MUST BE BOLTED TO THE FLOOR. NO SCREWS.**
6. No special bumpers, extra weights, trailer hitches, roll bars, special lifts, air lifts, block, shackles, or any reinforcements except as stated above will be allowed. All trunks must be empty of all debris, spare parts, etc... and NO add on parts of any type. That means NO metal, plastic, or rubber, etc.
7. Bolting of radiator can be done with no larger than 3/8-inch bolt from top radiator support to bottom radiator support. NO BOLTING TO FRAME.
8. No welding of leaf springs or coil springs.
9. All doors and wagon gates must be strapped or welded shut or YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
10. Trunk lids may be secured shut - NO SOLID WELDING - (5 inch of weld, 10 inch skip.)
11. Hoods are allowed one chain in the center of hood connected to top radiator support. NO ready rods or welding allowed. Hood MUST be open for inspection. **ALL HOOD LATCHES MUST BE REMOVED.** Hood may be tied down with no larger than #9 wire. May be tied in 6 different locations. "Fender to hood" or "hood to top radiator support." All cars must have a minimum of 2 12-inch holes must be directly above engine. All cars must have 2 10-inch holes in trunk lid.
12. SAFETY BELTS, HELMETS, AND EYE PROTECTION REQUIRED.
13. TIRES: Load Range B (4 ply Rating) OR LESS Standard Load (4 ply rating) OR LESS, air only in tires. **MARK LOAD RANGE AND PLY RATING OF TIRE WITH BRIGHT PAINT.** No LT tires (Light Truck) allowed. **NO RETREAD TIRES OR CAPPED TIRES.**
14. NO DRIVER OR PIT CREW MEMBER, UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF LIQUOR, WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE OR ENTER THE EXHIBITION AREA.
15. NO PIT CREW allowed in show arena during the heats or feature.
16. No welding or bolting of bumper shocks. Shocks must move freely upon impact.
17. In the interest of safety, a bar will be allowed behind drivers seat to run from left doorpost to right doorpost. A pipe may be installed from front door post to front door post (not on doors) in dash area. No other support allowed.

18. No added reinforcement allowed in fenders. Fenders may be cut and/or removed at any time during event for inspection. No outside door bars allowed.
19. NO disfiguring of body or frame before or after inspection.
20. No tying of car frame to rear axle.
- 21. DECISIONS OF OFFICIALS IS FINAL! NO ARGUING WILL BE TOLERATED OR YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND ESCORTED OFF THE PREMISES!!!!**
- 22. ALL OFFICIALS AND JUDGES ARE VOLUNTEERS – GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS MANDATORY.**
- 23. OFFICIALS CAN'T WATCH EVERYONE – THEY DO THE BEST THEY CAN – PLEASE RESPECT THEIR CALLS.**
