RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entries accepted until close of weigh in at 12:30 p.m. Sunday, July 30. (Weigh in 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.)
2. All entries must be made on entry blanks, which may be obtained free by addressing the Department Superintendent or by downloading them from the fair website. These forms are to be filled out and signed by exhibitor, and Mailed to Dubuque County Fair, Entry Department, 14569 Old Highway Road, Dubuque, IA 52002, before or by July 15. Do not make entries for Champion classes.
3. Each fee must accompany the entries.
4. Entry fee of \$25.00 per head will be charged.
5. Beef cattle for exhibition in The Open Class Tri-State Steer & Heifer Department may be Placed in the barn a ny time after 8:30 p.m. Saturday, July 29, and before 12:30 p.m. Sunday, July 30.
6. All steers and heifers shown by breed must have registration papers. Minimum number of animals for a breed show will be four; otherwise they will be exhibited in the Commercial Division.
7. Exhibitors are expected to obey the superintendent promptly in producing their stock when instructed to do so. Stock must be in the ring within ten minutes after the class has been called, and it will be taken for granted that any person failing to comply with this rule is not a competitor for the premium offered. Exhibitors must show their animals at such times and places as directed and furnish such information concerning their stock as may be required by the Superintendent. In case of refusal to obey this rule, any or all premiums will be forfeited and the exhibitor barred from showing.
8. No animals will be awarded a prize unless removed from its stall and exhibited in the show ring.
9. Exhibitors must keep the space in the rear of their stalls clean and clear; all litter must be placed where indicated by the Superintendent of the Department.
10. All animals exhibited must meet the Requirements of Livestock for Exhibition in the State of Iowa listed in the online fair book.
11. Animals will be shown by halter.
12. All IJBBA members bust exhibit in a collared/crewneck sleeved/short sleeved shirt and must stay tucked in during exhibition. Any IJBBA member not complying with the dress code will be disqualified.
13. Health papers required.
