GENERAL INFORMATION

3000 RPM Limit in Classes 1-7

GENERAL RULES

1. Keep in mind the safety of the crowd and your self when operating your machine.
2. Violation of any rule shall constitute a disqualification.
3. Contest to be governed by three judges, with all decisions final.
4. Judges have the right to stop and disqualify any tractor if it is not being operated in such a manner as would be safe, SAFETY PAYS! IT DOESN'T COST!
5. Drivers must be 16 years of age or older to pull.
6. No tractors allowed to park along guardrail by the pulling track.
7. Someone must be seated in the seat when the tractor is running.

ADDITIONAL HOT CLASS RULES

1. All farm stock tractors have a 3,000 RPM limit.
2. No use of down draft carburetors on farm stock classes, but can modify manifolds with single carburetor.
3. Hot stock tractors running over 3,000 RPMs must have all safety equipment—side shields, tie bars, safety kill switch for ignition or air, wheelybars, safety blanket, proof of steel flywheel and wide front end. Roll bars are required due to insurance.
4. Hot stock 466 cu. In. limit has a turbo limit of 2.75" inlet and a 3" outlet.
5. Hot stock 640 cu. In. limit has a turbo limit of 3" inlet and 4" outlet.
6. All pulls are at pullers own risk and they are responsible for their actions.
7. Anyone protested and found to be illegal will be disqualified.
8. All tractor classes can run cut tires.

ELIGIBILITY OF TRACTOR

1. Contest open to all makes and models meeting stock rules.
2. Tractors may be entered in only two classes but only once in each class.
3. Weights may be transferred on a tractor but must be done before hook-up to weight machine.
4. Weight that is added to a tractor must be securely fastened, and any weights lost during pull will automatically disqualify the contestant.
5. No weight frame or weight may extend 24 inches beyond front of tractor or must not extend rearward more than 1 foot beyond rear tires and have a 6" by 6" clearance of drawbar.
6. All tractors must be equipped with workable rear wheel brakes.
7. Contest open to tractors with rubber tires—no 4-wheel drive, studs, chains or duals

8. Factory equipped (T04) or equivalent turbochargers allowed on 9,000, 11,000, 13,000 or 15,000. 3,000 Maximum RPM limit. Turbochargers must be UNDER the hood.
9. No pressurized tanks or oxygen injection allowed. Stock Fuel Only. Injection pumps may be external charged.
10. Stock block or stock replacement block manufactured for that tractor.
11. Diesel tractors shall have standard pump manufactured for that tractor.
12. All exhaust must discharge vertically upward above highest point of tractor with the exception of roll bars and should be securely attached.
13. Minimum drawbar length 18 inches from the center of rear wheel to point of hood and 20 inches high.
14. Drawbars must be equipped with a hitching device not less than ½ inch of thickness and must have a 3 inch diameter opening. Pulling point may not be more than 1½ inches from back edge of the hitching device.
15. No portion of tractor shall interfere with sled or sled hitch during pull.
16. No Turbo Charges allowed in Class 1, 2, 3 and a tire limit of 20-8-38.
17. 3,000 RPM maximum in classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7.

OPERATION OF CONTEST

1. Operators must remain seated during pull with at least one hand on the steering wheel.
2. Contestants may change gears if desired but must not do so before reaching the 50-foot marker.
3. Drivers will be allowed to stop and restart ONCE if they do so before reaching the 50-foot marker.
4. Tractors must remain within boundaries of contest course during the pull.
5. Number one puller will be test puller and may take pull or they may pull in third position. If weight machine needs further adjustment, first puller after each adjustment will be treated as number one puller. All decisions on re-pull must be made before tractor in question is unhooked.
6. Excessive loss of liquid by a tractor during contest on track will be cause for termination of that pull of a disqualification from class.
7. Contestants will be disqualified for failure to comply with any listed rules:
 - a. For tampering with the tractors of other contestants.
 - b. If drawbar moves in relation to tractor during pull.
 - c. If, in the opinion of the Officials, the contestant's driving or tractor would endanger the safety of personnel on the track.
8. If pull has to be stopped and a class is not completed, entry fee will be refundable to all pullers in that class.
9. If tractor's hitching device breaks, pull is over for the contestant.
10. NO ONE LESS THAN 14 YEARS OF AGE ALLOWED IN PITS.
