Beer Olympics Rules

- **Everyone MUST be 21 years of age**
- Teams must be made up of four (4) participants with a maximum of 12 teams
- An entrance fee of \$5.00 per person (\$20.00 per team) will be collected before the competition
- A waiver per participant must be signed at registration
- While each team will compete in each event, not every member of the team will compete in each event
- All judges' decisions are final

Beer Olympics Team Names

- Each team will need to create a team name at registration
- The name needs to be visible during the event as stickers, shirts, etc., to identify each player

Each Event and Rules

Beer Pong (also known as "Beirut")

Number of Participants: Two per team

Rules:

- 10 cups are placed in a 4-3-2-1 rack
- Both teams engage in a traditional eye-to-eye shootout to determine who goes first
- Teams are invited to invite a third member to attempt a "celebrity" shot a single time during the entire game
- If the ball is bounced into a cup, that cup and another are to be consumed by one team member
 - If the ball is bounced, it can be swatted
 - If a player knocks their own cup over on a swat, they must chug a can of beer. The opposition gets to shoot at will until that beer is finished
- **Point Value**
 - Each cup equals 2 points in value. The winning team will receive 10 points in value

Flip Cup

Number of Participants: Entire Team

Rules:

- Each team member will have a Solo cup with a beer
- The event begins with the first two participants toasting before chugging their beer and attempting to flip it until it lands on the table with the wide side down
- In the event of a tie, each team will choose one person to face off
- **Points Value**
 - Each cup flipped is worth 5 points in value
 - The winning team will receive 10 points in value
 - Teams can earn up to 30 possible points

Quarters

Number of Participants: Entire Team

Rules:

- One person from each team will start
- Each player will have 10 chances to make the quarter in the cup
- **Points Value**
 - If participant gets the quarter in the cup
 - 1st try = 10 points
 - 2nd try = 9 points
 - 3rd try = 8 points
 - 4th try = 7 points
 - 5th try = 6 points
 - 6th try = 5 points
 - 7th try = 4 points
 - 8th try = 3 points
 - 9th try = 2 points
 - 10th try = 1 point
 - Unable to make it = 0 points
 - Teams can earn up to 40 possible points

Beer Bowling

Number of Participants: Entire Team

Rules:

- One person from each team will start
- Each player must roll the ball underhand and not cross the line
- Each player will have 2 frames to knock down as many pins (bottles) as possible
- 5 frames
- **Points Value**
 - 1 pin (bottle) = 1 point
 - If a player knocks down all 5 pins (bottles) on the first roll = 1 extra point
 - Teams can earn up to 120 possible points

Beer Bags

Number of Participants: Two per team

Rules:

- Normal cornhole rules will apply
- Games will be played to 20
- **Points Value**
 - Each bag is worth 1 point in value
 - The winning team will receive an extra 10 points in value
 - Teams can earn up to 30 possible points

Possible Points Per Game

Beer Pong – 30 Points
Flippy Cup – 30 Points
Quarters – 40 Points
Beer Bowling – 120 Points
Beer Bags – 30 Points
Total – 250 Points
